Reduction of School Bus Service for the 2011-12 School Year

As a result of the current State financial crisis, the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District is planning for several budget cuts for next school year. At their meeting on February 15, 2011, the Board approved several reductions in school bus service to be effective in September 2011. The following is a list of the details.

All school bus service for Special Education students will continue.

There are no changes in bus service to High Schools.
