

School Security Guard Training Course

With the passage of SB 1626 in 1998, state law requires security guards in K-12 school districts or California Community College districts to complete a course of training developed by BSIS. The law took effect July 1, 2000, and effects guards working on school property for more than 20 hours per week.

Course Content

- Role and Responsibility of School Security Officer (4 hours)
- Laws and Liability (8 hours)
- Security Awareness in the Educational Environment (3 hours)
- Mediation/Conflict Resolution (4 hours)
- Disasters and Emergencies (1 hour)
- Dynamics of Student Behavior (3 hours)
- Examination (1 hour)
